BE IT RESOLVED BY THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF NOT LESS THAN TWO-THIRDS OF THE TOTAL VOTING STRENGTH OF THE LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF MONROE, NEW YORK, as follows:

Section 1. For the class of objects or purposes of financing the cost of the reconstruction of certain county highways and certain town and village highways eligible under Section 131-k of the Highway Law, including related incidental improvements, pursuant to a plan of financing for a project entitled “American Recovery and Reinvestment Act – Highways,” in and for the County of Monroe, New York (the “County”), there are hereby authorized to be issued ~~\$18,232,374~~\$17,282,374 bonds of the County, pursuant to the provisions of the Local Finance Law. The duly adopted current Capital Budget of the County, to the extent inconsistent herewith, is hereby amended to provide for the appropriation of the amount hereby authorized to pay the indicated portion of the cost of the aforesaid class of objects or purposes. The period of probable usefulness of the aforesaid class of objects or purposes is fifteen (15) years, pursuant to clauses (c), (d) and/or (e) of subdivision 20 of paragraph a of Section 11.00 of the Local Finance Law (it being hereby determined that such highways shall be of flexible pavement, rigid base or rigid pavement as described in said clauses (c), (d) or (e)).

Section 2. The maximum estimated cost thereof is ~~\$18,232,374~~\$17,282,374, and the plan for the financing thereof is by the issuance of ~~\$18,232,374~~\$17,282,374 bonds of the County herein authorized; provided, however, that to the extent any State and/or Federal aid and/or grant is received for the aforesaid purpose, such aid and/or grant shall be used to redeem any outstanding indebtedness incurred for such purpose or shall be applied, dollar for dollar, to reduce the amount of bonds to be issued for such purpose.
