PUBLIC HEARING:

Authorize Additions to the Monroe County Agricultural Districts -  
County Executive Maggie Brooks

Chairman Driscoll declared the Public Hearing open at 4:03 p.m. to authorize additions to the Monroe County Agricultural Districts.

The Deputy Clerk of the Legislature testified to a mailing of the notice of Public Hearing that was sent to Supervisors of the affected towns, and the Commissioner of Agriculture and Markets on August 21, 2006. The Deputy Clerk testified to affidavits of publication and posting of the same hearing notice in the Daily Record and Rochester Business Journal on August 18, 2006.

There was one speaker who signed up to address the committee. Mr. Frank Calev spoke in reference to property located at 2500 Rush Mendon Road, in the Town of Rush, consisting of approximately 60.4 acres, tax account number 214.01-1-22, owned by Stevens and Sons.

CLOSING OF PUBLIC HEARING:

Chairman Driscoll declared the Public Hearing closed at 4:19 p.m. He announced that the referral to authorize additions to the Monroe County Agricultural Districts would be voted on by the Planning and Economic Development Committee later in the meeting. He further stated that the Monroe County Legislature would vote on the matter at its meeting on Tuesday, September 12, 2006 at 6:00 p.m. He concluded by stating that following its approval and adoption, a report and revised map would be submitted to the New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets for final certification.

06-0260 - AUTHORIZE ADDITIONS TO THE MONROE COUNTY AGRICULTURAL DISTRICTS - County Executive Maggie Brooks

Monroe County Southeastern Agricultural District # 4:

- 2500 Rush Mendon Road, Town of Rush, consisting of approximately 60.4 acres, tax account number 214.01-1-22, owned by Stevens and Sons.

Monroe County Northwestern Agricultural District # 5:

- Redman Road, Town of Hamlin, consisting of approximately 91.4 acres, tax account number 020.03-2-4.2, owned by Wood Wise Land Co.
- 183 Parma Center Road, Town of Parma, consisting of approximately 102.5 acres, tax account number 043.04-1-7, owned by Arthur S. and Arthur P. Eichas.
- 2015 Manitou Road, Town of Ogden, consisting of approximately 5.1 acres, tax account number 087.02-2-29.2 owned by Sandra & Glenn Neumann.
- 2015 Manitou Road, Town of Ogden, consisting of approximately 17.7 acres, tax account number 087.02-2-29.3, owned by Sandra & Glenn Neumann.
- 2015 Manitou Road, Town of Ogden, consisting of approximately 39.1 acres, tax account number 087.02-2-29.5, owned by Sandra & Glenn Neumann.
